ADULT/YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ALL bowlers, both youth and adult, must be current USBC members and present their membership card at sign-in.
2. Sign-in begins at 12:00PM. Practice starts at 12:50 PM. Bowling starts at 1PM.
3. Pre-registered bowlers should plan on arriving at least 30 minutes prior to the start of bowling.
4. Pre-registration is recommended, however, walk-ins will be accepted if space is available. Walk-ins must arrive no later than 11:30AM to allow time to verify averages and get you entered into the computer system. Only cash payments will be excepted.
5. ALL averages must be verified. Youth bowlers must provide a current standing sheet with proof of average, within 1 week of tournament. Highest USBC average with a minimum of 12 games will be used. If no current average, youth may use 2023-2024 final average, minimum of 12 games. Adults will use 2023-2024 HIGHEST USBC average, minimum of 21 games (as found on bowl.com). If current season (2024-2025) USBC Certified League average for at least 21 games is 10 pins higher than the 2023-24 HIGHEST USBC BOOK average, that average will be used. If the entrant doesn't have an average from the 2023-24 season, the entrant shall use their current USBC Certified League average for at least 21 games (it will then be the responsibility of the entrant to submit a league standing sheet or appropriate documentation for verification). If no USBC average exists, bowlers will bowl scratch (225).
6. Team Handicap is 80% of 450. Doubles Average Cap will be 450.
7. Entry fee is \$30.00 per team. Lineage/Expenses \$15.00 per person. Please note that this is a scholarship tournament and all prizes will be awarded to the youth. The format for the tournament is 3 games of doubles on the same pair of lanes.
8. There will be an Optional Singles event for the youth for \$10 that will go 100% towards the prize fund for the Singles Event. If entered, the scores the youth bowl during the tournament will count as your Singles score.
9. 100% of the prize fund and bracket winnings will be awarded in the form of scholarships and placed in the USBC SMART program.
10. Awards will be based on a 1 in 5 ratio.
11. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours of the squad.
12. Attire: No hats. All bowlers must wear collared shirts. Pants should be in good condition and worn at the waist. Finger-tip shorts or skorts are permitted. USBC Jersey is allowed. Please note Rule 301b.
13. No electronic devices, phones, iPods etc. may be used during competition unless for a medical reason. Scoring devices will be permitted.
14. Bowlers are expected to practice bowling etiquette and one lane courtesy. Good Sportsmanship is a part of bowling etiquette!
15. Bowlers arriving late will start to bowl in the same frame the team is bowling. Zero scores for frames not bowled.
16. Tournament is subject to good weather conditions. During inclement weather, contact the center for further information. Should we need to postpone, the tournament will be held on alternate date at the discretion of the center.
